### **Tips:**

1. For cutwork designs, it's absolutely foolproof to choose thread color in similar color family with the basic fabric. It may be the same color, darker or lighter shade. Also, if you want the cutwork design to look nice on both sides (back and front), you may use **Matching Top & Bobbin Thread** for this:

2. Use the strongest water-soluble backing you can find. We use **Stabilize PRO WSB**. You may get it here:
